The purpose of this behavior contract is to establish clear expectations for attendees participating in the Tribal Youth Program. By outlining these expectations, we aim to create a safe, respectful and encouraging environment. This contract serves as a mutual agreement between the child, parents, and program coordinators to ensure that everyone understands their role in maintaining a positive and safe atmosphere.

Tribal Youth Program Attendee Expectations:

Participants are expected to treat everyone with kindness, respect, follow instructions, maintain a safe environment, take care of the program property, and be truthful and accountable in their actions. Listed will be the following rules that you are expected to follow while attending Program and the consequences that will result in not following these rules.

Respectful Behavior:

- I will treat all staff, volunteers and fellow attendees with respect and kindness.
- I will listen and follow instructions promptly.

Safety:

- I will report any unsafe behavior or situations to a Coordinator immediately.
- I will follow all safety rules and guidelines provided by TYP.

Physical Violence:

- I will keep my hands, feet and objects to myself at ALL times.
- I understand that Tribal Youth Program has NO TOLERANCE for physical violence, and this will result in an immediate consequence.

Responsibility:

- I will take care of all program materials, equipment, and property.

- I will arrive on time and be prepared to participate in all activities.
- I will complete any tasks or activities to the best of my ability.

NO Bullying:

- I will NOT engage in any form of bullying, teasing, or exclusion of others.
- I will stand up against bullying and support a positive and kind environment.
- I understand that Tribal Youth Program has NO TOLERANCE for bullying, and this will result in an immediate consequence.

Honesty:

- I will be truthful in my words and actions.
- I will take responsibility for my own behaviors and choices.

Consequences for NOT following Tribal Youth Program Rules and Expectations:

- 1. Verbal Warning:**
 - A Coordinator will discuss the inappropriate behavior with the attendees and remind them of their expectations.
- 2. Written Warning/ Call home:**
 - The attendee will receive a written warning, and the parents/guardian will be notified.
- 3. Loss of Privilege within Program:**
 - The attendee will lose privilege within program which may include not being allowed to use the Switch, attend a Field trip etc.
- 4. Temporary Suspension**
 - The attendee may be suspended from the program for a period of 1-5 days, if necessary, if the behavior continues.
- 5. Permanent Suspension**
 - Repeated violations may result in the student being permanently removed from the program.

Please note that Physical Violence, Bullying, and Drug Use is not tolerated at Tribal Youth Program and will result in an automatic suspension.

Parent/Guardian Expectations:

As the Parent/Guardian, you are encouraged to communicate with the program coordinators and address any concerns you may have about your child, other attendees, or the Tribal Youth Program. We ask that you support your child in following the program

rules and expectations. We ask that you support the Youth Coordinators decisions regarding the rules and expectations, including any necessary consequences for inappropriate behavior.
